	<i>2020, our harvest in Aÿ, Dizy, Hautvillers, Champillon (55%), Avize and Oiry (45%): the winter was mild and very rainy, while spring was very sunny and dry. Following the June storms, drought set in until the end of September. An early harvest from 26 August to 10 September delivered excellent ripeness and remarkable balance. Sustainable viticulture, respectful of both soil and vine, in the service of parcel diversity. Vinification and ageing in oak vats, without filtration or fining. Chardonnays define this blend, despite the addition of 24% reserve wines, composed of Cuvées no. 747 to 743 and Cuvée no. 741.</i>

	<i>2015, our harvest in Aÿ, Dizy, Hautvillers, Champillon (60%), Avize and Oiry (40%): winter and much of spring were mild and rainy, followed by a period of drought and intense heat lasting until mid-August. The season ended with alternating spells of cool, humid weather and dry warmth. Harvested from 10 to 30 September, the crop was homogeneous, with perfectly ripe and healthy grapes, in reasonable quantities and with sufficient acidity—a splendid harvest. The character of Pinot stands out in this blend, which includes 21% reserve wines from Cuvées no. 742 to 735. Aged for 89 months on lees, under cork.</i>
